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During Enrollment:

- All grant recipients will learn sophisticated state of the art knowledge and skills to meet diverse students' needs
- All grant recipients will receive full tuition scholarships, \$200 textbook stipends each semester, and travel stipends to attend and present at the annual Alabama Federation for Exceptional Children conference
- All grant recipients will be assigned to Transformational Mentoring Teams
- All grant recipients will receive expert coaching in real-time vis-à-vis Virtual Bug-in-Ear (VBIE) technology

After Graduation:

- All grant recipients will possess sophisticated state of the art knowledge and skills to meet diverse students' needs
- All grant recipients will be eligible for certification in Special Education (AL CTP K-6) and receive a Master's degree in Special Education and therefore be dually certified
- All grant recipients will receive initial and ongoing assistance to successfully transition employment from general to special educator
